



Volunteer Help Team Task Description Swim Marshal

Thank you for joining the HELP TEAM. As a Weet-Bix Kids TRYathlon Volunteer, you'll be instrumental in making a real difference to Aussie kids who have entered, and to their supporting friends and family, as we direct and encourage kids to complete the TRY challenge and get a great boost in self-confidence.

Swim Marshals perform the following duties:

1. Maintain safety of participants in and around the swim area.
2. Assist with general information enquires, referring to FAQ sheet provided on the day. If you are not sure how to answer then refer patrons to the nearest Team Leader or back to the Information Tent.
3. Help guide parents to specific areas such as Swim viewing area, toilets, First Aid Tent and the Information & Meeting Point Tent (where lost kids and parents can find each other).

Swim Course Marshals will be given one of two jobs:

1. Marshal:

- Marshal participants in and around the swim area.
- Keep parents and spectators away from participant areas.

2. Age Group Marshal:

- Hold an Age Group sign so that it is visible.
- Gather all participants for the Age Group together in one area.
- Assist the Starter in starting the Age Group, sending them off in small groups of 6-10 participants at one time.

Please stay in your area. If you must leave at any time please let your team leader know first.

At the conclusion of the event, we also require your help with packing up. Please check with your team leader for instructions on assisting with packing up and **ensure all tasks are completed prior to signing out at INFORMATION and leaving.** A light lunch will be provided.
